PUBLIC NOTICE

As a friendly reminder the City wants to inform property owners that they will need to maintain and keep their properties free and clear of these common code violations:

Tall Weeds and Grass

Allowing weeds, grass or brush to grow and not be maintained or cultivated is a violation of City Code.

Property owners and tenants are responsible for keeping their lawns mowed including their alley.



Accumulation of Rubbish and Garbage and Outside Storage

It shall be unlawful for any owner or occupant to permit the accumulation of rubbish, trash or solid waste or excessive junk and debris on their property.

Excessive debris includes, but is not limited to, discarded furniture, fixtures, scrap building materials, motor vehicle parts and tires, lumber or metals and appliances



Inoperable Vehicles and Yard Parking

Residents are not allowed to park their vehicles in the front or side yard unless there is a permanent surface of concrete, brick, or asphalt with defined borders designated for parking.

No inoperative or unlicensed motor vehicle shall be parked, kept or stored on any premise in the public's view, and no vehicle shall at any time be in a state of major disassembly or disrepair.
